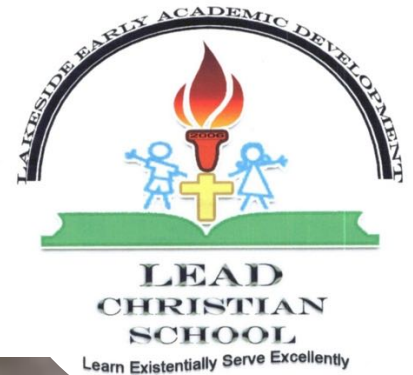

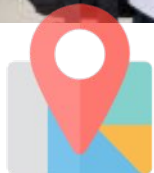
Introduction

The vision was conceived by a man's genuine love and passion as well as a strong belief that his very own community will be uplifted economically and spiritually. This is by properly equipping the young together with their family who are its future and source of hope.

LEAD CHRISTIAN SCHOOL whose commitment is to pursue its vision: **"to lead learners excel in academics and develop upright persons who will glorify God",** formally started operations in June 2006.

The succeeding years of operations were most challenging due to the financial crisis but quite fulfilling. Upon the school's accomplishment of becoming a part of every child's nurturing years, they are in the process of being molded as upright and productive citizens in the community.



Location

LAKESIDE EARLY ACADEMIC DEVELOPMENT (LEAD) CHRISTIAN SCHOOL is strategically and conveniently situated at **124 F. Gomez St., Purok 2, Barangay Aplaya, City of Sta Rosa, Laguna**, which serves as our MAIN GATE. This is just a stone's throw from the community's Barangay hall and very proximate from the main intersection leading to and from Barangays: Caingin, Aplaya, Sinalhan, Ibaba, and nearby villages. The school is just less than 5 minutes away from the town proper. The area's population has a rough estimate of not less than 50,000 families. The immediate surroundings are quite busy but entirely peaceful, which is highly conducive to the learning process.



The school was given the privilege to use the open space of an adjacent subdivision (DeLima Subdivision I), by means of a memorandum of agreement, it allows us to partner with their HOA in maintaining the cleanliness and peace and order, thereby connecting our school to the nearby villages and Barangays such as Ibaba and Malusak. This is a welcome opportunity for the institution to offer our services and cater to the needs of the said communities.

Our Approach

Elementary school is a pivotal time in a child's life. These first years are a time of intellectual curiosity and represent a child's first contact with structured learning. However, young students do not learn at the same rate in all subject areas. The School follows the Ministry of Education's Cycle System which allows elementary students to develop at their own pace and to acquire knowledge according to their ability.
